- (7) (b) Any person who shall knowingly and willfully make, cause to be made, or participate in the making of, any false entry in any annual or other report required under this section to be filed, * * * or shall knowingly or willfully file with the Commission any false report or other document shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject, upon conviction in any court of the United States of competent jurisdiction to a fine of not more than five thousand dollars or imprisonment for not more than two years, or both such fine and imprisonment: * * *
- (7) (c). Any carrier, or lessor, * * * or any officer, agent, employee, or representative thereof, who shall fail to make and file an annual or other report with the Commission within the time fixed by the Commission, or to make specific and full, true, and correct answer to any question within thirty days from the time it is lawfully required by the Commission so to do, shall forfeit to the United States the sum of one hundred dollars for each and every day it shall continue to be in default with respect thereto.
- (8) As used in this section * * * the term "carrier" means a common carrier subject to this part, and includes a receiver or trustee of such carrier; and the term "lessor" means a person owning a railroad, a water line, or a pipe line, leased to and operated by a common carrier subject to this part, and includes a receiver or trustee of such lessor, * * *.

Each respondent is further required to send to the Bureau of Accounts, humediately upon preparation, two copies of its latest annual report to stockholders. See schedule 108, page 1.

2. The instructions in this form should be carefully observed, and each question should be raswered fully and accurately, whether it has been answered in a previous annual report or not. Except in cases where they are specifically authorized, cancellations, arbitrary check marks, and the like should not be used either as partial or as entire answers to inquiries. Commission means the Interstate Commerce Commission. Respondent means each person or corporation in whose behalf the report is made. The year means the year ended December 31 for which the report is made. The close of the year means the close of business on December 31 of the year for which the report is made; or, in the case the report is made for a shorter period than one year, it means the close of the period covered by the report. The beginning of the year means the beginning of business on January 1 of the year for which the report is made; or, in case the report is made for a shorter period than one year, it means the beginning of the period covered by the report. The preceding year means the year ended December 31 of the year next preceding the year for which the report is made. The Uniform System of Accounts for Railroad Companies means the s, stem of accounts in Part 1201 of Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, as amended.

REMARKS

The operating property of the Ann Arbor Railroad from Toledo, Ohio to Ann Arbor, Michigan to Cadillac was acquired by the State of Michigan on April 1, 1976.

The property consisting of land, tracks, operating, and miscellaneous equipment was purchased as a whole for \$ 1,294,530.00. An additional \$ 516,455.96 was paid to the Manufacturer's National Bank of Detroit for the purchase of 40 Hopper Cars and 10 Diesel Locomotives. The total acquisition costs totaled \$1,810,985.96. Except for equipment purchased through the Manufacturer's National Bank, there are no records available to determine the distribution of costs between land, tracks, operating, and miscellaneous equipment.
