

Class S4. Bridge and ferry. This class of companies is confined to those whose operations are limited to bridges and ferries exclusively. Class SS, Mixed. Companies performing primarily a switching or a terminal service, but which also conduct a regular freight or passenger traffic. The revenues of this class of companies include, in addition to switching or terminal revenues, those derived from local passenger service, local treight service, participation in through movement of freight or passenger traffic, other transportation operations, and operations other than transportation.
