An "Electric" unit includes all units which receive electric power from an overhead contact wire or third rail, and use the power to drive one or more electric motors that propel the vehicle. An "Other self-powered unit" includes all units other than diesel or electric, e.g., steam, gas turbine. Show the type of unit, service and number, as appropriate, in a brief description sufficient for positive identification. An "Auxiliary unit" inleudes all units used in conjunction with locomotives but which draw their powr from the "mother" unit, e.g., boosters, slugs.

7. Column (h) should show aggregate capacity for all units reported in column (g), as follows.
