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

Respondent was incorporated August 25, 1909 for a period of 25 years under the general laws of the Territory of Arizona, the purpose being to construct, equip, maintain and operate a bridge with approaches thereto over the Rio Grande River between Brownsville, Texas and Matamoros, Mexico for the purpose of passage of railroad tracks, street railways, wagons and vehicles of all kinds, and for the transit of foot passengers and animals. The construction was financed through issue of \$333,000 First Mortgage 5% Bonds and the issue of \$500,000 capital stock which is owned equally in shares by the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company and the National Railways of Mexico. In June 1913 the company increased its capital stock by purchase of the capital stock of the Brownsville Ferry Company, Itd. of New York in the amount of \$150,000 and issued 1,500 shares of capital stock, 750 shares to the St. Louis, Brownsville & Mexico Company (Missouri Pacific Railway Company, successor) and 750 shares to the National Railways of Mexico. The company is not a consolidated, merged or reorganized company. Ownership and control of 3,250 shares of capital stock formerly held by the St. Louis, Brownsville & Mexico Railway Company passed to Missouri Facific Railroad Company on March 1, 1956, pursuant to Consumation Order and Final Decree in Proceedings for Reorganization of Missouri Pacific Railroad Company, Debtor No. 6945, issued March 1, 1956, ICC F.D. 9918.
