The Company is not a consolidated, merged or reorganized Company. Ownership and control of 3,250 shares of capital stock formerly held by the St. Louis, Brownsville & Mexico Railway Company passed to Missouri Pacific Railroad Company on March 1, 1956, pursuant to Consummation Order and Final Decree in Proceedings for Reorganization of Missouri Pacific Railroad Company, Debtor No. 6935, issued March 1, 1956, ICC F.D. 9918
