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

Note 1.

Effective January 1, 1976 the respondent adopted the Louisville and Nashville Railroad Company Employees' Supplemental Retirement Plan for the benefit of non-union employees retiring on or after January 1, 1976. This Pian was merged into Seaboard Coast Line Railroad Company's Plan, effective January 1, 1978. The name of the merged plan was changed to the Family Lines System Employees' Supplemental Retirement Plan.

Based upon the latest actuarial report dated January 1, 1978, received from the Wyatt Company, actuary for the plan, the maximum contribution required to pay the normal cost and budget the net accrued liability over 8 years (the amortization period represents the remaining duration of a 10 year period which began January 1, 1976) is \$12,620, if made at the end of the year. Of this amount \$3,106 represents current service cost and \$9,514 past service cost. The total amount of \$12,620 is accrued as pension expense for the year 1978, which is the maximum amount which may be allowed as a tax deduction for 1978, on the basis of one IRS criterion. This is consistent with prior years.
