Contingent Liabilities

The Federal income tax returns for 1956, 1957 and 1963 through 1965 are under review by the Internal Revenue Service. The returns for 1958, 1959, 1967 and 1968 were not examined by the Internal Revenue Service; therefore, the years are now closed by the operation of the Statute of Limitations. The taxes for the years 1960 through 1962 and 1966 have been settled. The returns for 1969 and subsequent years are subject to review by the Internal Revenue Service. State income taxes cannot be finally determined until the Federal tax liability is settled. Provisions for possible Federal and State tax deficiencies have been made in the Company's accounts.

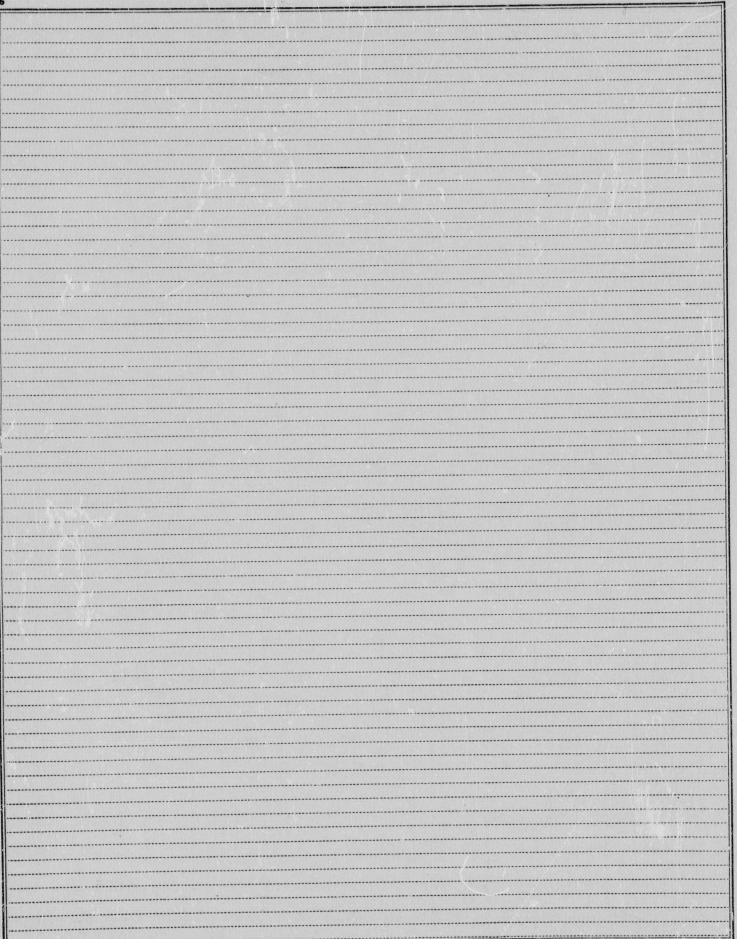
