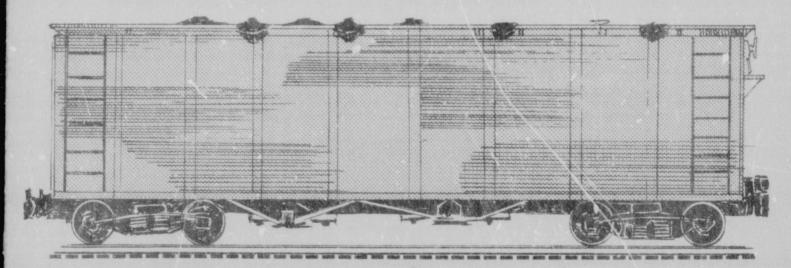

Class S3. Both switching and terminal. Companies which perform both a switching and a terminal service. This class of companies includes all companies whose operats as cover both switching and terminal service, as defined above.

Class S4. Bridge and ferry. The class of companies is confined to those whose is, erations are named to bridges and ferries exclusively.

Class SS. Mixed. Companies performing primarily a switching or a terminal service, but which also conduct a regular freight or passenger traffic. The revenues of this class of companies include in adds on to switching or terminal revenues, those derives from local passenger service, local freight service, participation in through movement of freight or passenger traffic, other their portation operations, and operations other than transportation.
