Class 11 rate bureaus shall file only the carrier statistics (ITEMS 1-9) and certification (page 4) portions of the Annual Report Form RBO.

If any inquiry does not apply to the respondent, such fact should be shown in the inquiry by the words. Not applicable. Where the word "None" trub, and completely states the fact, it should be given as the answer to any particular inquiry or any particular portion of any inquiry. It means the close of the period covered by the report, the beginning of the year means the heginning of business on January 1 of the year for which the report is made or, in ease the report is made for a shorter period than one year. It means the beginning of the period covered by the report.
