- 3 Equipment On line 6 show the total weight in tons of 2,000 pounds. The weight of the on lines 23 and 26 the number of cars leased of record as of the close of the year. Cars shown on year from others, does not include short-term rentals. Show on line 9 the cars undergoing and awaiting repairs, and bad order cars in or out of shops awaiting disposition.
