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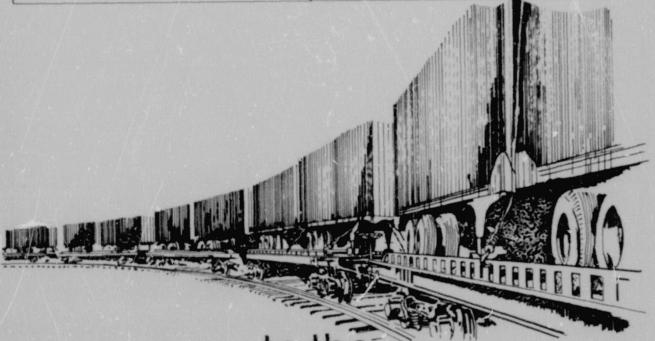

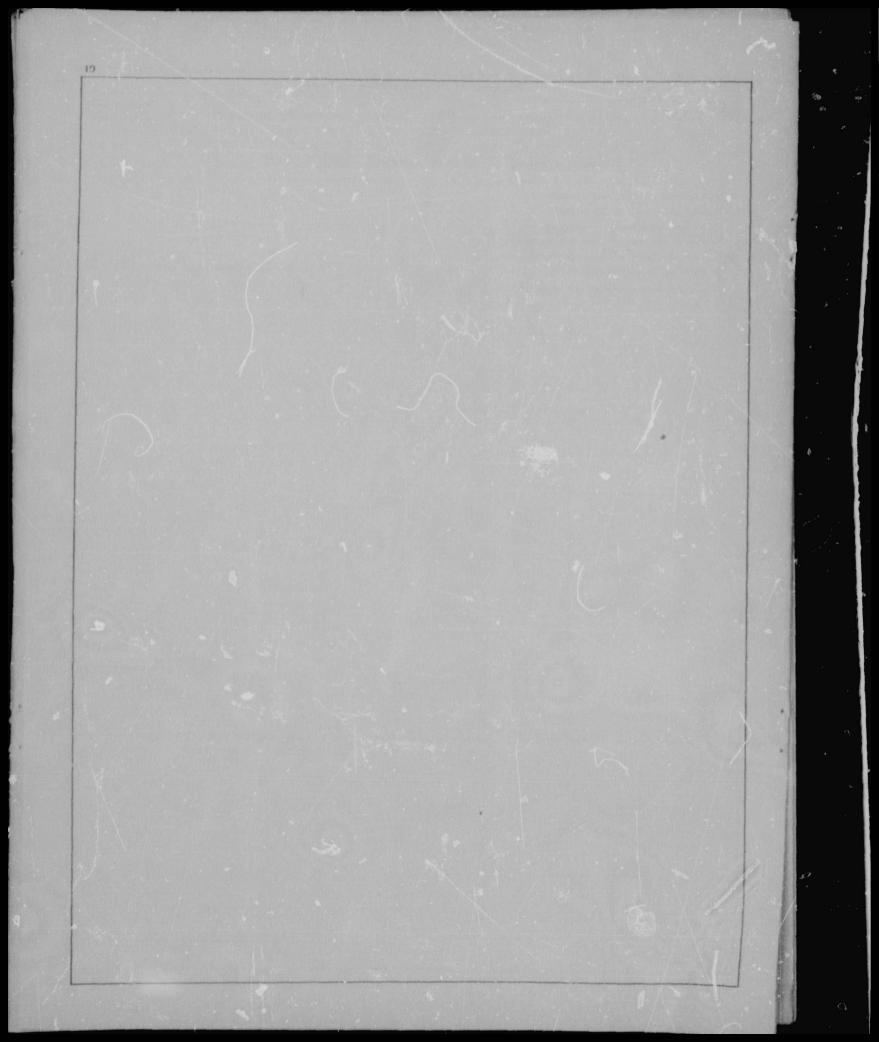

By Finance Docket No. 28100 tha S. C. Public Railways Commission was authorized to begin construction of the East Cooper and Berkeley Railroad Company (ECBR) on July 15,1977.

On November 9, 1978, the S. C. Public Railways Commission sold \$7,807,459 worth of the ECBR assets to Amoco Chemicals Corporation on a lease back arrangement. The sale was consummated for the purpose of retiring partial retirement of construction debt. The sale price was \$7,988,908. The assets were leased back at a lease rental rate of 14% of the ECBR gross revenues and paid monthly.

On November 15, 1978 the ECBR began operations.

The ECBR has no employees. All personnel services for the ECBR are purchased from the S. C. Public Railways Commission. Compensation for officers is paid by the S. C. Public Railways Commission with the ECBR paying its pro rata share to the S. C. Public Railways Commission.

On December 31, 1978, \$2,197,037 was owed to Amoco Chemicals Corporation. This debt resulted from additional construction. The money was advanced free of interest with the intention that a final loan agreement would be signed after all construction costs were known and operating revenues were high enough to ensure repayment.
