

STATEMENT II - CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP

On June 30, 1978, THE GREATWESTERN SUGAR COMPANY, holder of all issued and outstanding stock, sold 100% ownership interest to THE INTERAIL SYSTEM, a joint venture of 22 Commerce Road, Inc. and Mid-Rail, Inc., both New Jersey Corporations.
