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

On January 22, 1978, the Corporation leased the Keene, N.H. yard of the 8 % M Railroad, within specified limits, to do switching and make up trains. The lease will remain in effect until cancelled by either party. The rent for these facilities is \$1,528 per car for an engine and the yard facilities.
