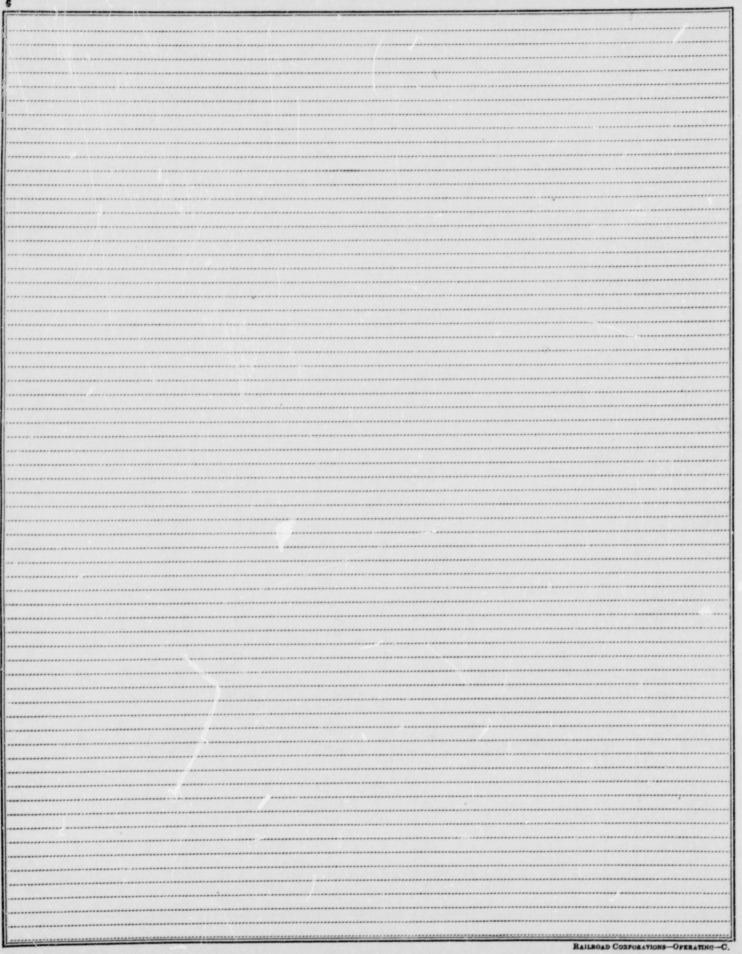

701. ROAD AND EQUIPMENT PROPERTY
