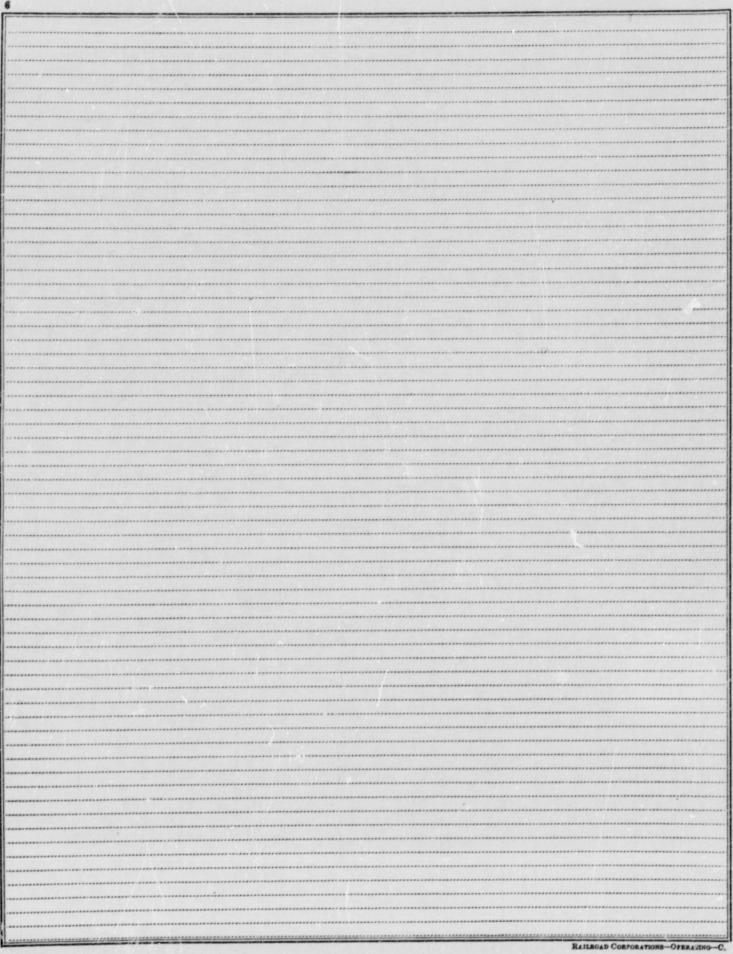

#### 701. ROAD AND EQUIPMENT PROPERTY

1.
