



Extraordinary Item:

The extraordinary credit resulted from the reduction in the amount of deferred tax necessary to provide for the recapture of accumulated tax losses of Erie Lackawanna Railway Company to the Internal Revenue Service. This accounting was approved by the Interstate Commerce Commission, Bureau of Accounts, by letter addressed to Norfolk and Western Railway Company, Parent Company, dated March 9, 1979.
