12. The respondent was incorporated April 24, 1962 under the general corporation laws of the State of Ohio as Midway Railroad Company, a wholly owned subsidiary of the Columbus and Scuthern Ohio Electric Company.

Railroad assets were acquired from Ohio-Midland Light and Power Company. The transaction was authorized by The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, order number 30,614, dated March 13, 1962. The Interstate Commerce Commission authorized the acquisition and operation of the railroad by the respondent on Docket No. 22601, dated October 28, 1963. Authority was granted to the respondent to issue 397 shares of no-par value common stock having a stated value of \$1,000 per share on Docket No. 22602, dated October 28, 1963.

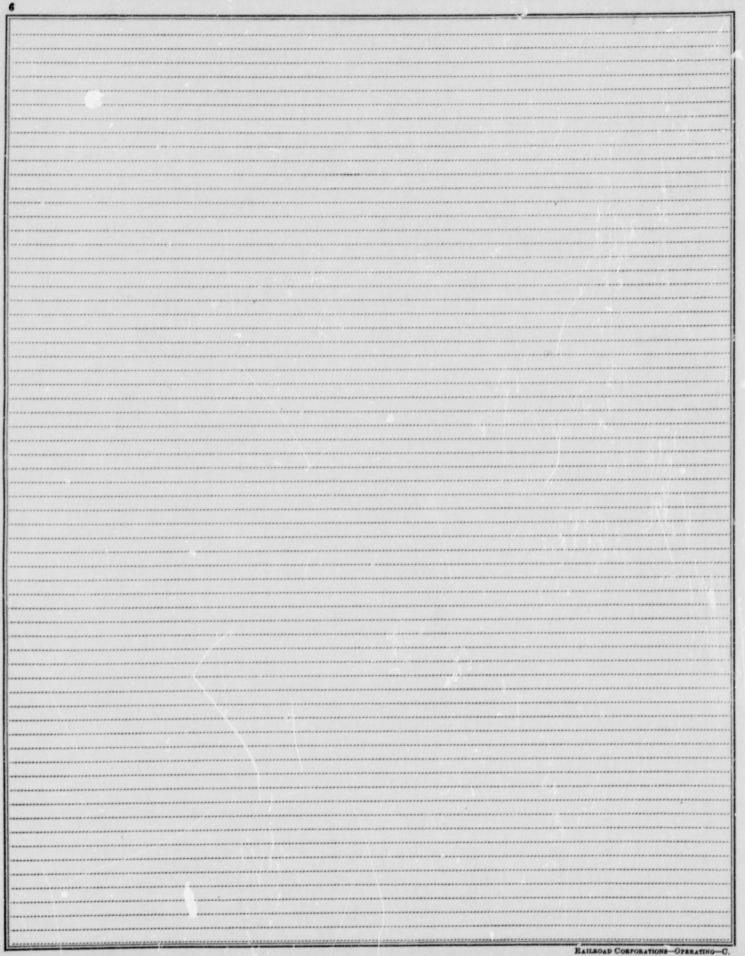
