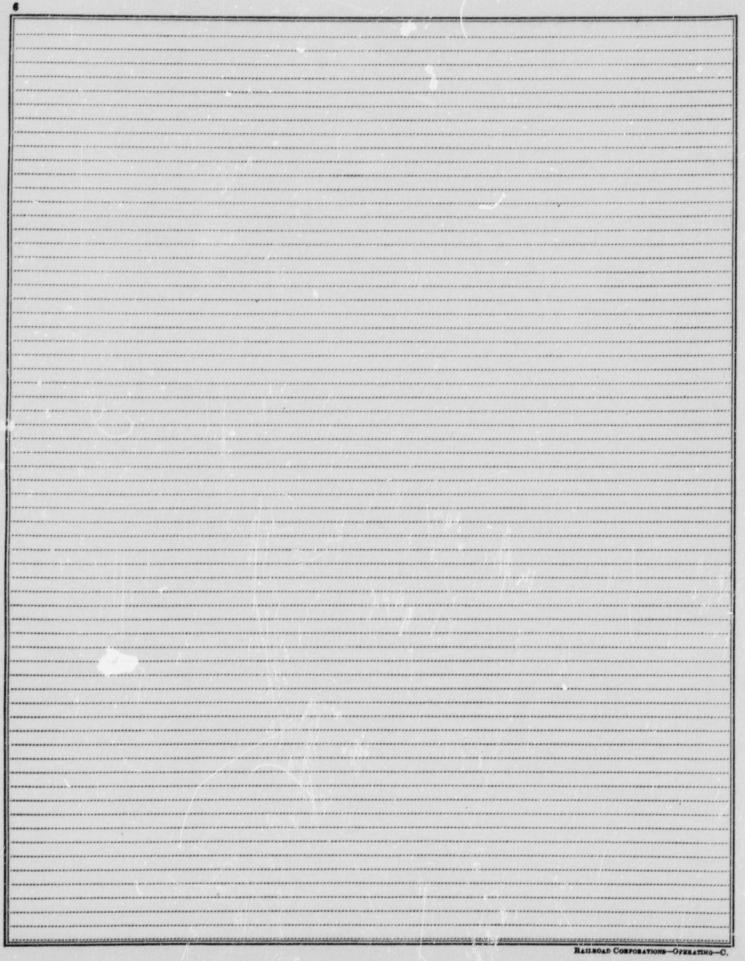

- 12. If the cost of any investment made during the year differs from the book value reported, explain the matter in a footnote. By "cost" is meant the consideration given minus accrued interest or dividends included therein.
- 13. These schedules should not include any securities issued or assumed by respondent.
