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

Washington, D.C. 20423, by March 31 of the year following that for which the report is made. Attention is specially directed to the following provisions of Part I of the Interstate Commerce Act:

Sec. 20. (1) The Commission is hereby authorized to require annual, periodical, or special reports from carriers, lessors, * * * (as defined in this section), to prescribe the manner and form in which such reports shall be made, and to require from such carriers, lessors, * * * specific and full, true, and correct answers to all questions upon which the Commission may deem information to be necessary, classifying such carriers, lessors, * * * as it may demi proper for any of these purposes. (2) Said annual reports shall contain all the required information for the period of twelve months ending on the 31st day of December in each year, unless the Commission shall specify a different date, and shall be made out under oath and filled with the Commission at its office in Washington within three months after the close of the year for which report is made, unless

additional time be granted in any case by the Commission

(7) (b). Any person who shall knowingly and willfully make, cause to be made, or participate in the making of, any faise entry in any annual or other report required under the section to be filed, * * * or shall knowingly or willfully file with the Commission any false report or other document, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject, upon conviction in any court of the United States of competent jurisdiction, to a fine of not more than five thousand dollars or imprisonment for not more than 100 years, or both such fine and imprisonment * * *

(7) (c). Any carrier or lessor, * * * or any officer, agent, employee, or representative thereof, who shall fait to make and file an annual or other report with the Commission within the time fixed by the Commission, or to make specific and full, true, and correct answer to any question within thirty days from the time it is lawfully required by the Commission so to do, shall forfer to the United States the sum of one hundred dollars for each and every day it shall continue to be in default with respect thereto.

(8). As used in this section " * " the term "carrier" means a common carrier subject to this part, and includes a receiver or trustee of such carrier, and the term "lessor" means a person owing a railroad, it water line, or a pipe line, leased to and operated by a common carrier subject to this nar, and includes a receiver or trustee of such lessor. * "

The respondent is further required to send to the Bureau of Accounts, immediately upon preparation, two copies of its latest annual report to stockholders. See scheduled 108, page 3.

- 2. The instructions in this Form should be carefully observed, and each question should be answered fully and accurately, whether it has been answered in a previous annual report or not. Except in cases where they are specifically authorized, cancellations, arbitrary check marks, and the like should not be used either as partial or as entire answers to inquiries. Class I companies att. those having annual operating revenues of \$5,000,000 or more. For class, Annual Report Form R-1 is provided.

Class II companie, are those naving annual operating revenues below \$5,000,000. For class, Annual Report Form R-2 is provided.

In applying this classification to any switching or terminal compawhich is operated as a joint facility of owning or tenant railways, t sum of the annual railway operating revenues, the joint facility relincome, and the returns to joint facility credit accounts in operation expenses, shall be used in determining its class.

Switching and terminal companies are further classified as:

Class S1. Exclusively switching. This lass of companies includes all those perform switching service only, whether for joint account or for revenue.

Class S2. Exclusively terminol. This class of companies includes all companies furnish terminal tracking or terminal facilities only, such as union passenger or freight status stockyards, etc. for which a charge is made, whether operated for joint account or for rever In case a bridge or ferry is a part of the facilities operated by a terminal company, it should included under this heading.

Class S3. Both switching and terminal. Companies which perfore both a switching an terminal service. This class of companies includes all companies whose operations cover is switching and terminal service, as defined above.

Class S4. Bridge and ferry. This class of companies is confined to those whose operations limited to bridges and ferries exclusively.

Class SS. Mixed. Companies performing primarily a switching of a terminal service, but we also conduct a regular freight or passenger traffic. The revenues of this class of companinched, in addition to switching or terminal revenues, those derived from local passes service, local freight service, participation in through movement of freight or passenger the other transportation operations, and operations other than transportation.

Previous owner was Port Townsend Southern Railroad, Inc. Control secured by Oregon Improvement Company in 1880, taken over by Pacific Company in 1887, control transferred to N. W. Improvement Company in 1902, Mr. Joshua Green Majority Stockholder, secured control in May 1917, Road sold to R. S. Fox and Partners, January 1, 1945, this partnership was incorporated as of 1/2/75 as Port Townsend Railroad, Inc. As of Midnight, May 31, 1975 control was acquired by Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company, through purchase of all capital stock. Effective 12:01 A.M., June 1, 1975, stock of the company was cancelled; properties and franchises of Port Townsend Railroad, Inc., were merged in the acquiring company in accordance with agreement between the parties. These actions were taken pursuant to ICC Order dated March 13, 1975, under Finance Dockets 27810 and 27811.
