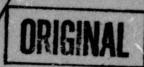

Sabine River and Northern Railroad was organized on April 20, 1965, and construction was completed February 16, 1968. This company became fully operational on August 17, 1967. It was financed through the issurance of \$1,000,000 common stock, \$1,500,000 registered depentures and \$100,000 unsecured note.
