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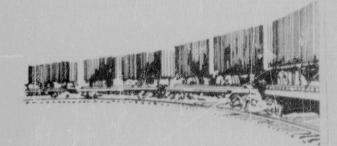

Class 1. Exclusively switching. This class of companies includes all those performing switching service only, whether for joint account or for revenue.

Class \$2, Exclusively terminal. This class of companies includes all companies furnishing terminal trackage or terminal facilities only. Such as union passenger or freight stations, stockyards, etc., for which is charge is made, whether operated for joint account or for revenue. In case a bridge or ferry is part of the facilities operated by a terminal company, it should be include under this heading.
