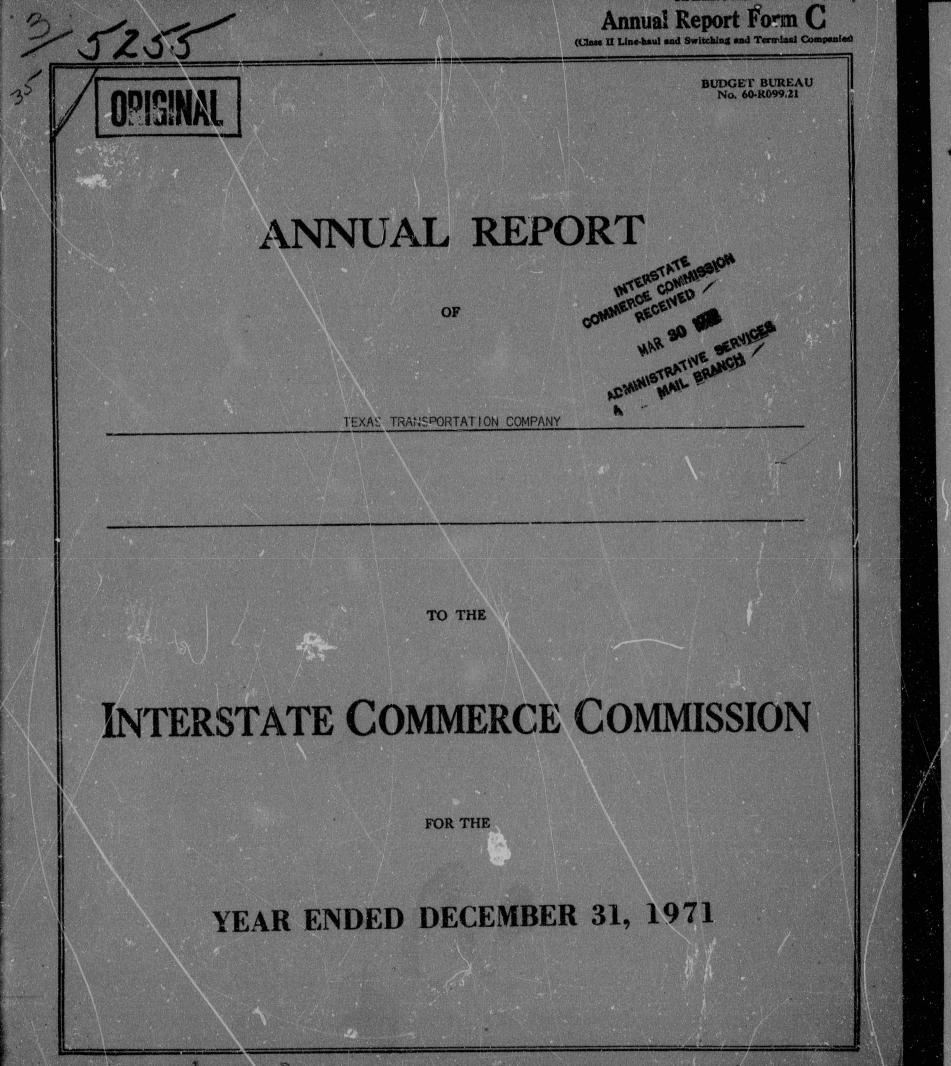
791. ROAD AND EQUIPMENT PROPERTY

1. Give particulars of changes during the year in accounts 731, "Road and equipment property," and 732, "Improvements on leased property," classified in accordance with the Uniform System of Accounts for Railroad Companies. 2.
