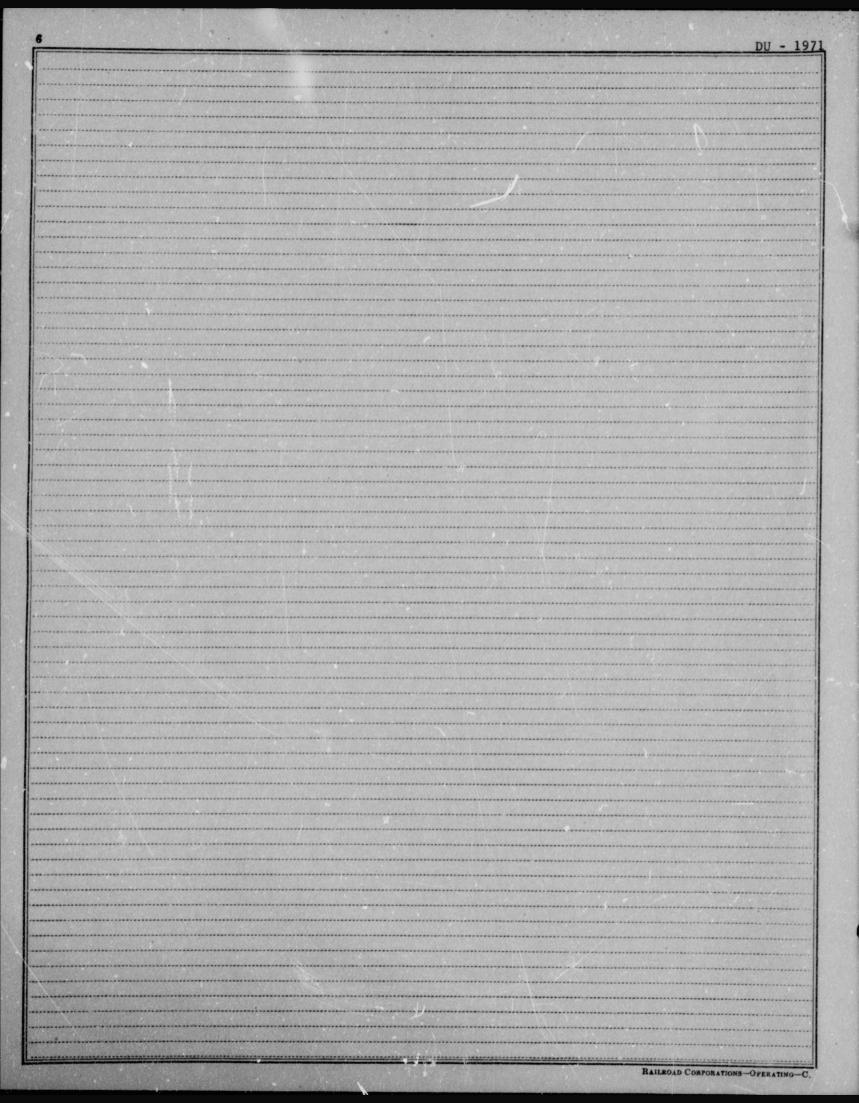

6.
