5. Records, accounts, working papers, and other documents reflecting the revenue, cost and service unit data for each branch line for which the railroad must maintain data shall be made available for inspection and examination by the Commission and for lines situated within it state, by the designated state agency at a time and place mutually agreeable to the parties. The railroad shall also reproduce such records for the designated state agency, sovided the agency pays the reasonable cost thereof.
