The Annual Meeting of Stockholders will be held at Roanoke, Virginia, on Tuesday, May 16, 1972.

To the Stockholders:

The following report of the affairs of The Lake Erie and Fort Wayne Railroad Company is submitted for the year ended December 31, 1971.

Total railway operating revenues for the year amounted to \$67,365, an increase of \$24,055 that primarily reflects intra-plant switching rate increases of 4% on November 20, 1970 and 15% on April 20, 1971. In addition, there was an increase in traffic of 424 cars as compared with the year 1970.

Total railway operating expenses during the year amounted to \$49,016, an increase of \$3,989 as compared to the previous year. This increase was primarily due to wage rate increases granted during 1971.

There were no changes during the year in Road and Equipment Property, which on December 31, 1971 was \$121,833.

Authorized and outstanding Capital Stock of the Company as of December 31, 1971 was \$100,000, consisting of 4,000 shares having a par value of \$25.00 each. There were no changes during the year.

Financial and operating statements are submitted herewith.

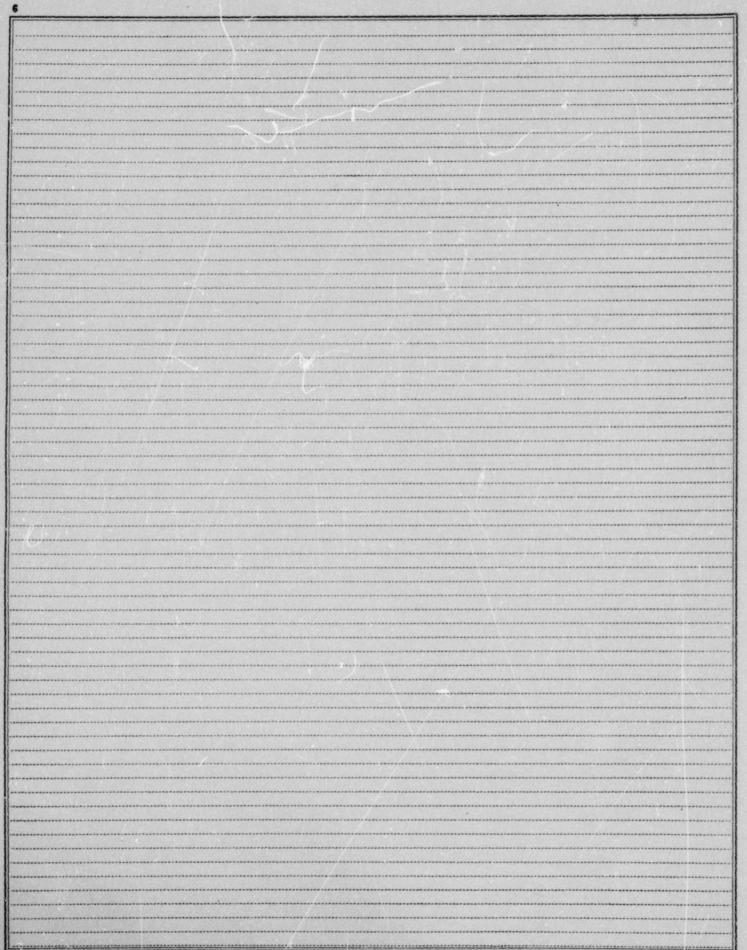
