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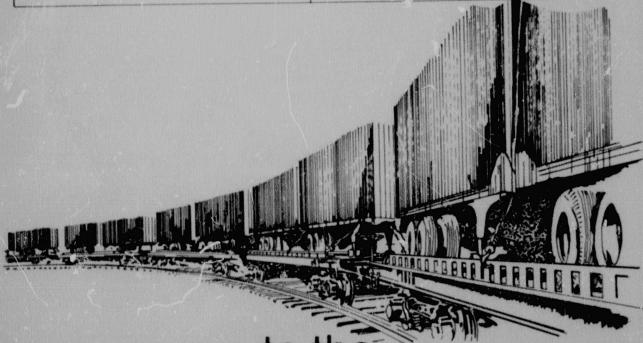

The River Terminal Railway Company participates as a qualified subsidiary in pension plans of Republic Steel Corporation. The plan covers eligible how paid employees and eligible salaried personnel. Republic Steel Corp. administers the plan.

The River Terminal Railway Company makes contributions to the plans annually. The total contribution authorized and paid into the pension trust fund for the year 1978 amounted to \$761,500. The amounts are based upon actuarial computations as related to the company's experience and circumstances, and in accordance with the terms set up in the plans.

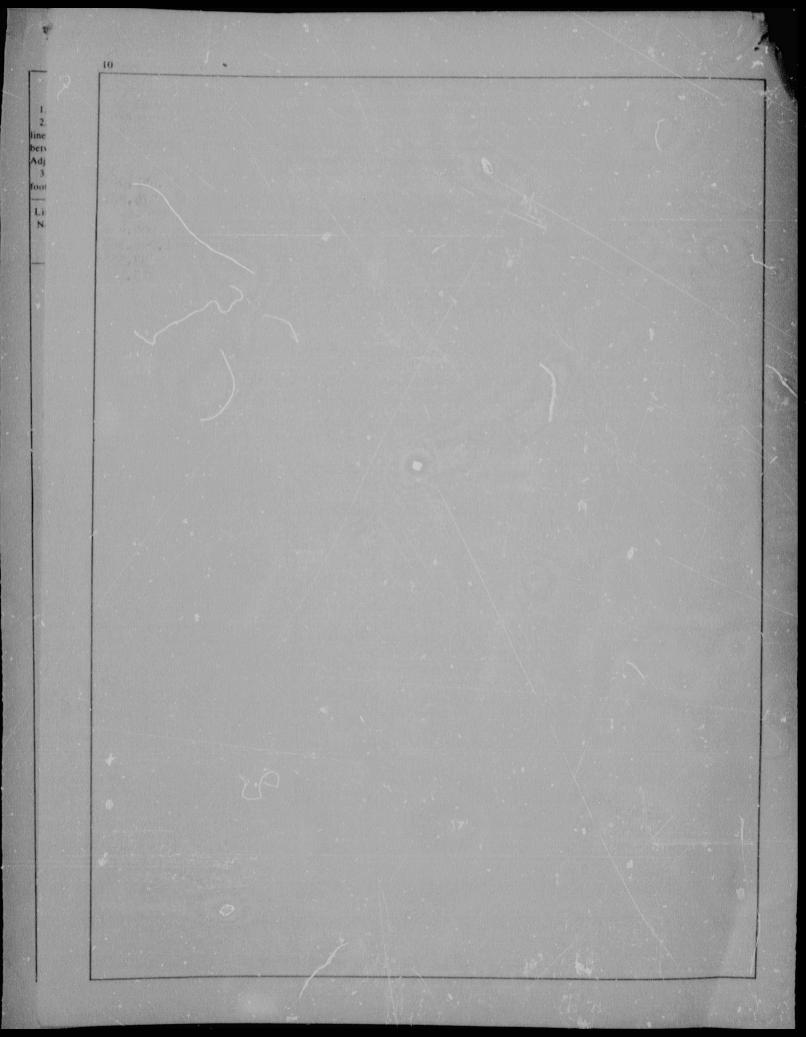
