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

Item 12 - The PB R.R. was incorporated on March 22, 1974, but was inactive from that date until receipt of the approval of Finance Dockets 27608 and 27609, authorizing W.R.R.C. to begin operation. Because of a conflict in the initials of the name of the railroad, the name was subsequently changed on September 22, 1975 to the Western Rail Road Company.

In accordance with the course of action set forth in the above referenced finance dockets, the construction of the approximately 1.9 miles of main line was begun in late 1975 and completed in December of 1975. Financing for track construction was provided through the sale of 10,000 shares of common stock and debt financing was secured from a bank.




