Dear Chairman Elliott, Vice Chairman Miller, and the Honorable Ms Begeman:

I am writing in response to the Board's Order in Docket No. EP 724 (Sub-No 2) dated June 20, 2014 directing Canadian Pacific Railway Company (CP) to produce a grain order backlog plan, and provide weekly status reports on various metrics. This is CP's Seventh Weekly Report.

For Grain Week 52, new requests totaled 1,276, including those on the Rapid City, Pierre & Eastern Railroad (RCP&E). We fulfilled 2,188 grain orders this week, of which 409 were cars delivered to the RCP&E. See Appendix 1. CP also supplied RCP&E with an average daily count of 52 locomotives over the past seven days. See Appendix 2.

We remain focused on moving as much grain as possible and communicating with our customers across the network
