Dear Chairman Elliott, Vice Chairman Miller, and the Honorable Ms Begeman:

I am writing to provide comment on the service data that we are filing contemporaneous herewith in response to the Board's data collection order of October 8, 2014.

Our US network continues to be in good operating condition. Average dwell at origin for unit grain trains has improved, and grain loadings remain steady. Train speed has increased.

With respect to the Rapid City, Pierre & Eastern Railroad (RCP&E), locomotives are in overall balance this reporting week, understanding that the number varies from day to day. We fulfilled 237 of 300 RCP&E grain car requests, which is an improvement over last week. We will continue to work with our interchange carriers and the other components of the supply chain to balance the return of empty grain cars from the east.
