Dear Chairman Miller, and Vice Chairman Begeman:

I am writing to provide comment on the service data that we are filing contemporaneous herewith in response to the Board's data collection order of October 8, 2014.

Of note this week, our outstanding grain car orders are down to 39, and we received 853 new grain car orders. We spotted a total of 2177 grain car orders this reporting week, which total includes single cars and cars in dedicated trains. We also note that the Chicago Terminal has returned to normal operating condition.

With respect to the Rapid City, Pierre & Eastern Railroad (RCP&E), RCP&E made a request for 98 grain cars this week and we delivered 98 grain cars to them. On average this reporting week there were four more RCP&E locomotives on CP than CP locomotives on RCP&E, which is consistent with the level of demand on RCP&E.
