Dear Chairman Miller and Vice Chairman Begeman:

I am writing to provide comment on the service data that we are filing contemporaneous herewith in response to the Board's data collection order of October 8, 2014.

Of note this reporting week, our outstanding grain car orders remain at zero. We received 577 new grain car orders this reporting week, and spotted a total of 1550 grain cars, which total includes single cars and cars in dedicated trains. We remain current in the United States from a grain order perspective.

We also note that Canadian Pacific Railway Company train and engine employees in Canada went out on strike beginning at midnight Saturday, February 14, 2015. They returned to work on Tuesday, February 17. In anticipation of the possibility of this strike, we reduced starts of US grain trains westbound into Canada during the reporting week. When Canadian train and engine employees returned to work, we resumed these train starts on a metered basis.

With respect to the Rapid City, Pierre & Eastern Railroad (RCP&E), RCP&E made a request for five grain cars this week and we delivered five grain cars to them. On average this reporting week there was one more RCP&E locomotive on CP than CP locomotives on RCP&E, which is consistent with the level of demand on RCP&E.
