Dear Mr. Elliott, Ms Begeman and Ms Miller:

I am writing to provide comment on the service data that we are filing contemporaneous herewith in response to the Board's data collection order of October 8, 2014.

CP's US network continues to be fluid and in good operating condition, as it has for months. Again this week, system average train speed, weekly average terminal dwell, and cars on line data are all good.

We do have a few (50) outstanding grain car orders this reporting week, but consider our grain order status as current. We spotted a total of 2302 grain cars this week, which total includes single cars and cars in dedicated trains, and we received 1774 new grain car orders.

The Rapid City, Pierre & Eastern Railroad (RCP&E) did not request any grain cars this week. On average there was a minus one CP/RCP&E locomotive balance this reporting week, meaning there was one more RCP&E locomotive on CP than CP locomotives on RCP&E.
