Dear Mr. Elliott, Ms Miller and Ms Begeman:

I am writing to provide comment on the service data that we are filing contemporaneous herewith in response to the Board's data collection order of October 8, 2014.

CP's US network continues to be fluid and in good operating condition, as it has for many months. Again this week, system average train speed, weekly average terminal dwell, and cars on line data are all good.

The number of outstanding grain car orders is again at zero this reporting week, where it has been for all but four of the last 51 weeks. We spotted a total of 1948 grain cars this week, which total includes single cars and cars in dedicated trains, and we received 1138 new grain car orders. From a grain order perspective, we remain current in the United States.

The Rapid City, Pierre & Eastern Railroad (RCP&E) did not request any grain cars again this week. There was a plus five CP/RCP&E average locomotive balance this reporting week, meaning that on average there were five more CP locomotives on RCP&E than RCP&E locomotives on CP.
