Dear Mr. Elliott, Ms Miller and Ms Begeman:

I am writing to provide comment on the service data that we are filing contemporaneous herewith in response to the Board's data collection order of October 8, 2014.

CP's US network continues to be fluid and in good operating condition, as it has for many months. Again this week, system average train speed, weekly average terminal dwell, and cars on line data are all good.

The number of outstanding grain car orders is again at zero this reporting week, where it has been for all but four of the last 52 weeks. We spotted a total of 1487 grain cars this week, which total includes single cars and cars in dedicated trains, and we received 828 new grain car orders. From a grain order perspective, we remain current in the United States.

We have received the Board's order discontinuing CP's reporting of Rapid City, Pierre & Eastern Railroad (RCP&E) data, effective February 23, 2016, and thank the Board for this decision.
