The number of outstanding grain car orders remains at zero this reporting week, where it has been for all but four of the last 62 weeks. We spotted a total of 1515 grain cars this week, which total includes single cars and cars in dedicated trains, and we received 349 new grain car orders. From a grain order perspective, we remain current in the United States.
