Dear Mr. Elliott, Ms Miller and Ms Begeman:

I am writing to provide comment on the service data that we are filing contemporaneous herewith in response to the Board's data collection order of October 8, 2014.

CP's US network continues to be fluid and in good operating condition, as it has for many months. Again this week, system average train speed, weekly average terminal dwell, and cars on line data are all good.

The number of outstanding grain car orders remains at zero this reporting week, where it has been for all but four of the last 66 weeks. We spotted a total of 1222 grain cars this week, which total includes single cars and cars in dedicated trains, and we received 514 new grain car orders. From a grain order perspective, we remain current in the United States.
