Dear Mr. Elliott, Ms Miller and Ms Begeman:

I am writing to provide comment on the service data that we are filing contemporaneous herewith in response to the Board's data collection order of October 8, 2014.

CP's US network continues to be fluid and in good operating condition, as it has for many months. Again this week, system average train speed, weekly average terminal dwell, and cars on line data are all good.

The number of outstanding grain car orders remains at zero this reporting week, where it has been for all but four of the last 71 weeks. We spotted a total of 1880 grain cars this week, which total includes single cars and cars in dedicated trains, and we received 720 new grain car orders. From a grain order perspective, we remain current in the United States.

We have discovered that one of the data points we reported last week for 2016 Reporting Week 24 was in error. Item 8(c), the number of new (grain) car orders should have been 391 instead of 720. We are filing corrected data sheets for 2016 Reporting Week 24 today, together with this week's data (2016 Reporting Week 25).
